

## SAT Boot Camp 2018

The SAT Boot Camp is a six-week mentoring and intensive SAT test preparation program, focusing on math and writing skills necessary for success with SAT and college access. The program will run **June 25**<sup>th</sup> – **August 2**<sup>nd</sup>, Monday-Thursday from 8:30am-12pm for current 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders (entering 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall of 2018). **Every day attendance is mandatory.** The program is on the campus of Wayne State University and has limited spots available. First priority for this free, valuable program will be given to the most qualified applicants who submit complete, timely applications. Before you begin the application process, please read the information and instructions.

- Please make sure you include your high school transcripts, recommendation, and essay.
- Please make sure you read and follow all directions that are given on the application.
- The online application cannot be started and saved (have additional documents ready).
- The online application cannot be submitted until all fields are completed.
- Graduation will be held on August 2, 2018, 1-3 PM.
- Parents and participants will be required to attend an orientation in May or early June.
